Positive stories on steps taken against radical Islam

1. When dozens of terrorists attempted to storm the Bangi Police Station in Niger State's Mariga Local Government Area last Wednesday, they were reportedly neutralised. The

terrorists had encircled the police station and were going to terrorise the security officers when they were confronted with heavy resistance, resulting in the gunmen's deaths. However, it was discovered that a police officer, whose identity was not revealed, was hurt in the incident and died subsequently. During the counter-offensive, it was discovered that the terrorists employed 50 motorcycles in their operation, with some of the shooters escaping with bullet wounds.

The Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) and the internal security forces (Asayish) have arrested several Islamic State (ISIS) suspects and affiliates in a large-scale ongoing military operation in al-Hol camp in northeast Syria (Rojava), a conflict monitor reported on Saturday. The security forces have arrested several ISIS-affiliated men of different nationalities on Friday, the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights (SOHR) said, as the operation entered its fourth day.
