### **Taliban's extremist implementation of sharia law**

Around 400 women and girls, many of them in their late teens and early twenties, gathered on April 1 at a sports hall in Bamiyan's centre city for what they were told would be an opportunity to discuss their right to an education. The women tore down a flag and demanded to be heard when it turned out to be a rally for the local Taliban, with no mention of education.

1. German authorities detained a Syrian man on Wednesday, accusing him of war crimes for allegedly torturing hostages while serving with the terrorist organisation ISIS in Syria in 2014. The individual, named only as Raed E due to German privacy laws, was detained in Berlin, according to federal authorities. He is accused of being a member of a foreign terrorist organisation, as well as crimes against humanity, war crimes, and bodily harm. Prosecutors said the suspect joined ISIS in the summer of 2014 and took part in an attack on the Shueitat tribe in the Deir el-Zour region of eastern Syria in August of that year.

Musab Mutawa, aka Jamil Al-Ghazzawi, the son of Jamil Mutawa, was one of the operatives slain, according to Egyptian officials. In Khan Younis, he is the president of Hamas charity foundations. Jamila Al-Sinwar, his mother, was the sister of Yahya Al-Sinwar, the chairman of Hamas' political office in Gaza.

8. Anti-terrorism court on Thursday granted physical remand of suspect Saifur Rehman in Anarkali blast case until April 12, ARY NEWS reported. The investigation officer asked the ATC to extend the physical remand by 14 days. The court however extended the remand to April 12 after the suspect was presented in the court under strict security measures. The Punjab government has constituted a joint investigation team (JIT) headed by superintendent police (SP) Counter-Terrorism Department (CTD) Naseebullah Khan to probe into Lahore's Anarkali Bazaar bomb blast.
