A Uyghur educator and high school principal in Ghulja in northwestern China's Xinjiang region who went missing nearly a year ago is being detained in the city, municipal education officials told RFA. Dilmurat Abdurehim has been missing since the Eid al-Fitr Muslim religious holiday on May 13, 2021, that marked the end of the holy month of Ramadan. He left his home in the city's Dongmehelle area but never returned, said a source with knowledge of the situation who requested anonymity for security reasons.
