1. Tibet's Security Linked to Global Freedom (3.10.25)

Sikyong Penpa Tsering stressed that Tibet's freedom is intertwined with global liberty and democratic values. He argued that China's control over Tibet has broad implications for international human rights, security, and global democratic resilience.

2. Dolma Gyari Engages Indian Academia (3.10.25)

Deputy Speaker Dolma Gyari met professors at the Central University of Himachal Pradesh to deepen academic collaboration. Discussions focused on Tibetan history, democratic governance in exile, and strengthening Indo-Tibet cultural and educational ties.

3. Tibetan Film Weekend Held in Sweden (3.10.25)

A two-day Tibetan film event took place in Sweden, featuring documentaries, interactive sessions, and cultural discussions. The program aimed to educate European audiences on Tibet's identity, resilience, and ongoing struggle.

4. Tibetans & Chinese Protest Embassy in Austria (3.10.25)

Tibetans and Chinese activists jointly staged a protest outside China's embassy in Austria. The rare alliance highlighted shared concerns about authoritarian policies, human rights abuses, and Tibet's suppressed freedoms.

5. France Exhibition Draws Thousands (3.10.25)

An exhibition in France on His Holiness The Dalai Lama's life attracted thousands. Featuring Buddhist teachings and Tibetan arts, it strengthened public understanding of Tibet's spiritual culture and highlighted France's support for Tibetan heritage.

6. China Enforces “Xizang” in Place of Tibet (12.10.25)

China intensified efforts to replace “Tibet” with “Xizang” in official records and platforms. The linguistic shift aims to reshape global perception, reinforcing China’s narrative and eroding Tibetan identity internationally.

7. Sikyong in Prague for Global Democracy Conference (13.10.25)

Arriving in Prague, Sikyong participated in the Forum 2000 gathering, engaging global thinkers, activists, and policymakers. His presence highlighted Tibet’s role in global democracy discussions and resistance to authoritarian systems.

8. Petoen School Marks 20 Years (13.10.25)

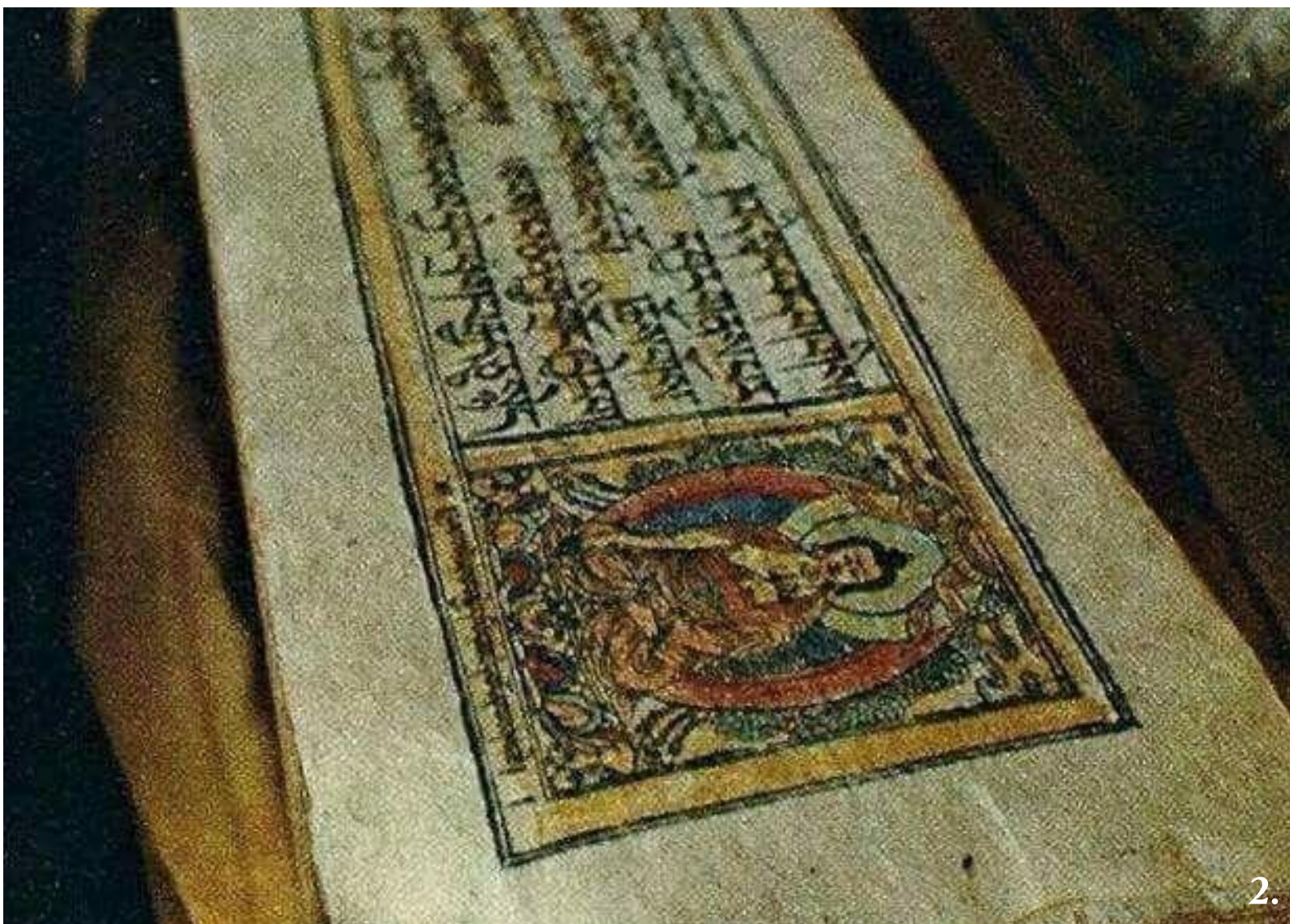
Mewoen Tsuglag Petoen School celebrated its 20th anniversary, showcasing achievements in Tibetan-medium education and cultural preservation. The event underlined the community’s commitment to nurturing Tibetan identity among younger generations.

9. Tibet at Forum 2000: "Where Will China Stop?" (14.10.25)

At Prague’s Forum 2000, Sikyong spoke on China’s authoritarian expansion and its implications. Tibet was emphasised as a frontline struggle against totalitarianism, urging the international community to resist China’s coercive influence.

10. EU PARLIAMENT DEMANDS PANCHEN LAMA’S RELEASE (17.10.25)

EU lawmakers called for the unconditional release of the 11th Panchen Lama, disappeared since 1995. The statement reaffirmed Europe’s commitment to religious freedom and urged China to respect Tibetan spiritual rights.



11. Election Commissioner Visits Tibetan Settlements (19.10.25)

Additional Election Commissioner Tsering Youdon completed visits across Tibetan settlements to oversee electoral preparations. The outreach reinforces the democratic functioning and self-governing structures of Tibetans in exile.

12. Dharamshala Hosts Mind & AI Conference (19.10.25)

Over 120 scholars and practitioners met in Dharamshala to explore consciousness and artificial intelligence through Tibetan Buddhist and scientific perspectives. The conference bridged philosophy, ethics, and emerging technology debates.

13. Ghoton Celebration at Sonam Norboo Hospital (20.10.25)

The Tibetan community at Sonamling settlement celebrated Ghoton, the Dalai Lama's 90th birth-anniversary year, at a local hospital. The event combined cultural devotion, community unity, and respect for healthcare institutions.

14. Chinese Raid on Monastery for H.H Dalai Lama Photo (21.10.25)

Chinese authorities conducted raids at a major monastery outside TAR, confiscating images of His Holiness The Dalai Lama. The move highlights intensifying restrictions on religious expression and efforts to suppress Tibetan loyalty to their spiritual leader.

15. WESTERN MASSACHUSETTS MARKS THE 18TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE U.S. CONGRESSIONAL GOLD MEDAL AWARD TO H.H THE DALAI LAMA (22.10.25)

In western Massachusetts an event commemorated the 18th anniversary of the U.S. Congress's gold-medal award to the Dalai Lama, underscoring enduring American support for Tibetan religious freedom and non-violent struggle.





16. Indo-Tibet Society Meets Dalai Lama in Tawang (22.10.25)

Members of the Indo-Tibet Friendship Society in Tawang received an audience with the Dalai Lama. The meeting reinforced India-Tibet cultural bonds and community support for Tibet's spiritual and political aspirations.

17. CCP INSTITUTIONALISES CONTROL OVER TIBETIAN BUDDHISM (22.10.25)

A report revealed the CCP has systemically embedded surveillance mechanisms inside Tibetan Buddhist institutions. Monks, teachings, and monastic activities are monitored to enforce ideological control, eroding spiritual autonomy and cultural heritage.

18. Rome Screens Dalai Lama Documentary (24.10.25)

Cinema Barberini hosted a special screening of *Wisdom of Happiness*, a Dalai Lama documentary. The screening introduced Italian audiences to Tibetan philosophy, compassion principles, and the global significance of Tibet's spiritual heritage.

19. Election Awareness Campaign in Bylakuppe (27.10.25)

Chief Election Commissioner conducted awareness programs on upcoming Tibetan elections in Bylakuppe. The initiative emphasises civic participation, electoral literacy, and democratic culture within the exile Tibetan community.

20. TIBETAN LEADERSHIP MEETS GERMAN LAWMAKERS (30.10.25)

Sikyong engaged German parliamentarians and civil society members in Berlin to advocate Tibet's cause. Discussions centred on human rights, cultural preservation, and Europe's role in supporting Tibetan self-determination and democratic values.
