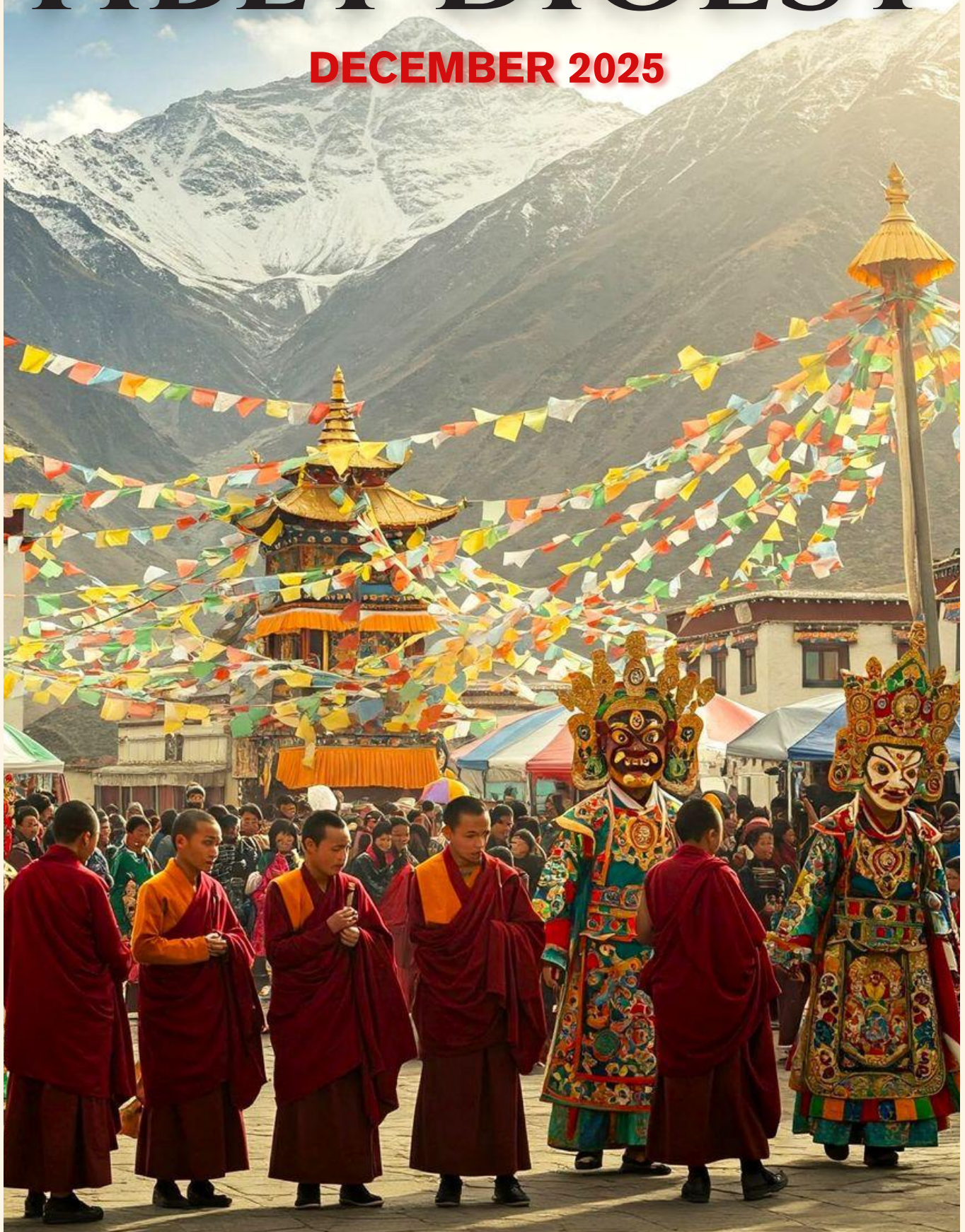

1. His Holiness the 14th Dalai Lama Offers Prayers for Victims of Storms in Asia (2.12.25)

His Holiness the Dalai Lama expressed condolences for lives lost in recent storms across Asia, offering prayers for the deceased and their families. He extended sympathies to affected communities and conveyed hopes for swift recovery and resilience for survivors facing hardship.

2. CTA Delegation Calls on Himachal CM to Invite Him as Chief Guest for the 36th Anniversary of the Nobel Peace Prize Conferment on His Holiness the Dalai Lama . (3.12.25)

9. Tibetan Parliament-in-Exile Commences Tibet Advocacy Efforts in New Delhi. (15.12.25)

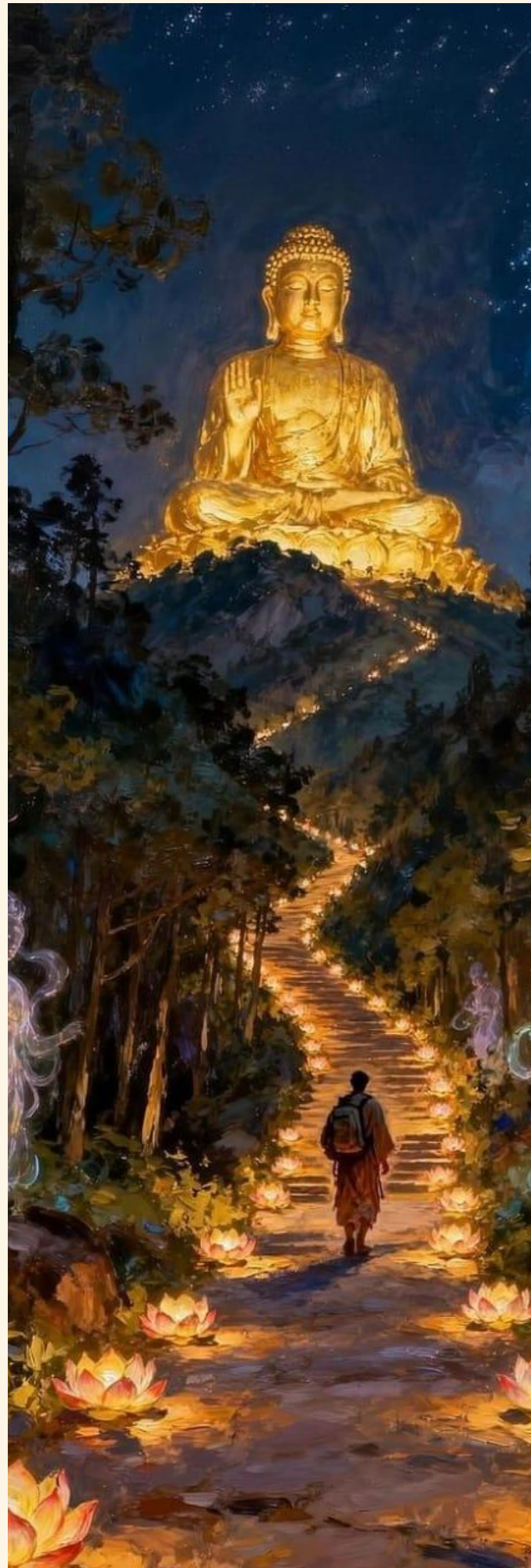
