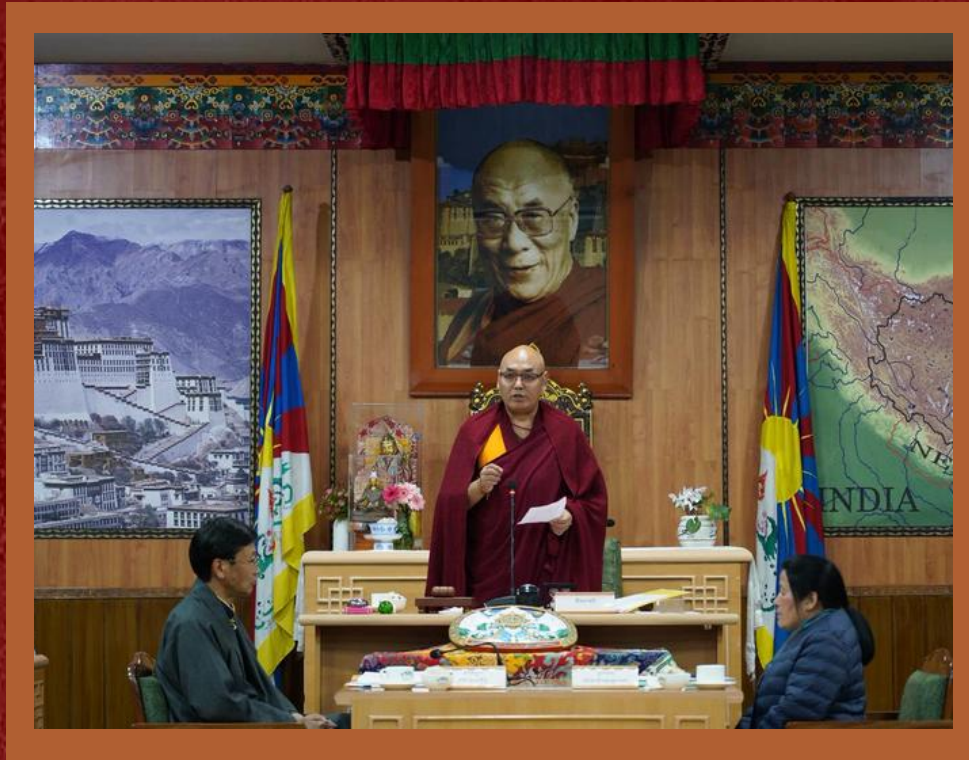
TIBETAN DIGITAL LIBRARY CONFERENCE HIGHLIGHTS HERITAGE PRESERVATION

Representative Rigzin Genkhang met French President Emmanuel Macron, marking a significant diplomatic engagement for the Tibetan cause. The meeting reflects continued outreach by the CTA and international recognition of Tibet-related concerns at the highest political levels.



CZECH SENATE BACKS H.H DALAI LAMA'S AUTHORITY ON REINCARNATION

In a historic resolution, the Czech Senate affirmed that only His Holiness the Dalai Lama has authority over his reincarnation and rejected any role for China. The move is a major symbolic and political endorsement of Tibetan religious freedom.



SIKYONG SIGNS STANDARDISED TIBETAN NATIONAL SYMBOLS

Sikyong Penpa Tsering formally signed the standardised Tibetan national symbols following their adoption by Parliament. The move represents an effort to strengthen Tibetan national identity, institutional coherence, and symbolic continuity within the exile administration.
