#### **1. Concerns raised on student decline for preserving Tibetan education and culture.**

Sikyong Penpa Tsering visited the Central Institute of Higher Tibetan Studies, Varanasi . He highlighted the decline in student enrolment and urged more youth participation in preserving Tibetan education and culture.

#### **2. Shimla Local Assembly sworn in**

The 11<sup>th</sup> Local Tibetan Assembly of Shimla took oath. Members pledged to strengthen Tibetan democracy in exile and work collectively for the welfare of their community.

#### **3. Seattle hosts 30<sup>th</sup> Tibet Fest**

Seattle celebrated the 30th Tibet fest with music , dance , food and culture . The event fostered compassion , unity and awareness of Tibetan traditions among local and international audiences.

#### **4. Tibetan New Year celebrated in Victoria Parliament**

Victorian Parliamentary Friends of Tibet, TAG Australia and the Tibetan community marked the ‘Year of Compassion’ at Victoria Parliament, showcasing Tibetan culture and strengthening political and community ties.

#### **5. Tibetans celebrate India's 79<sup>th</sup> Independence Day**

The Central Tibetan Administration honoured India's 79<sup>th</sup> Independence day , recognising India's support for Tibetans in exile and celebrating shared democratic values and cultural ties.



#### **6. Dalai Lama Teaches on Mind Training**

His Holiness the Dalai Lama gave teachings on “Eight Verses on Training the Mind” and the “Four Mindfulnesses,” inspiring followers toward compassion, awareness, and spiritual practice.

#### **7. Kullu-Manali Tibetan Settlement Outreach by CTA**

Sikyong Penpa Tsering visited Tibetan settlements in Kullu-Manali. He addressed local Tibetans, encouraging unity, resilience, and preservation of Tibetan culture amid ongoing challenges.

#### **8. China Politicises Reincarnation System**

The Tibetan Buddhist reincarnation system is under political control by China. A recently released report criticised Beijing’s interference in spiritual traditions, calling it a tool to legitimize rule over Tibet.

#### **9. Xi Jinping’s Visit Shows Weak Confidence**

Xi Jinping’s visit to Lhasa reflected China’s insecurities about its rule in Tibet. Analysts saw it as Beijing’s attempt to project control amid growing international criticism.

#### **10. US Report Condemns Human Rights Conditions in Tibet**

The US State Department reported severe human rights abuses in Tibet. Restrictions on religion, culture, and freedom of expression continue under Chinese authorities, drawing global concern.

#### **11. Political Prisoner Jamyang Lekshey’s Plight**

The story of Tibetan political prisoner Jamyang Lekshey highlighted China’s suppression of dissent. His case reflects the harsh conditions faced by Tibetans demanding cultural and political rights from Beijing.
