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China's Ethnic Unity Law Comes Into Force

China's Ethnic Unity Law officially entered into force amid widespread international criticism.

Discussions centred on concerns regarding cultural assimilation, linguistic rights, religious freedoms, minority identity, and the legislation's broader implications for Tibetans, Uyghurs, and other ethnic communities within China.



China Conducts Carrier Drills Near Philippines

Chinese aircraft carrier operations east of the Philippines prompted Japan to monitor regional security developments. The exercises underscored China's expanding blue-water naval capabilities and growing military presence beyond the First Island Chain, raising concerns over strategic stability and freedom of navigation in the Western Pacific.



China-US Militaries Resume Direct Communication

Chinese and US military officials held constructive talks in Hawaii, stressing the importance of maintaining communication channels, managing operational risks, and preventing unintended escalation. Both sides discussed maritime and regional security issues, reaffirming the value of military-to-military dialogue despite broader strategic competition.



Solomon Islands Reassesses Security Partnerships

Solomon Islands' new government initiated a review of its security agreement with China while pursuing a comprehensive treaty with Australia. The move reflected efforts to balance external partnerships, strengthen regional security cooperation, and diversify strategic engagement amid increasing geopolitical competition in the Pacific.



China and South Korea Expand Aviation Cooperation

China and South Korea agreed to expand bilateral flight rights for the first time in seven years. The discussions focused on improving connectivity, boosting tourism and business exchanges, and supporting economic recovery while signalling gradual improvement in bilateral relations despite continuing strategic differences.



Weak Chinese Demand Pressures Iranian Oil Prices

Iranian crude traded at deeper discounts despite tighter global supplies due to weak Chinese demand. Market discussions centred on China's slowing refinery purchases, shifting energy consumption patterns, and their impact on Iran's export revenues and broader global oil market dynamics.



Taiwan and China Renew South China Sea Maritime Standoff

Taiwanese and Chinese coast guards engaged in renewed confrontations near a disputed South China Sea shoal. The exchanges highlighted competing sovereignty claims, intensified maritime patrols, and continued tensions over law enforcement activities in strategically significant waters.



Xi-Kim Meeting Reinforces Strategic Coordination

Xi Jinping and Kim Jong Un projected unity and strategic confidence during high-level talks in Pyongyang. Discussions emphasised long-term bilateral cooperation, regional security, economic coordination, and resistance to external pressure while reaffirming the enduring China-North Korea partnership.



China Plans Massive National AI Infrastructure Investment

China prepared a proposed \$295 billion nationwide AI investment plan aimed at accelerating computing infrastructure, data centres, semiconductor development, and artificial intelligence innovation. The initiative seeks to strengthen technological self-reliance and global competitiveness amid intensifying technology rivalry.



Philippines Challenges Chinese Activities at Disputed Shoal

The Philippines urged China to dismantle a newly installed structure at a contested South China Sea shoal, warning against further island-building. Discussions focused on maritime law, territorial sovereignty, regional security, and preserving stability through adherence to international norms.



China's Export Controls Threaten Global AI Supply Chains

China's dominance over indium phosphide exports raised concerns about AI data centre expansion worldwide. Discussions centred on supply chain vulnerabilities, semiconductor materials, export controls, and the strategic importance of critical minerals for emerging technologies.



Taiwan Rejects Chinese Coast Guard Patrols

Taiwan declared it would expel Chinese personnel conducting unauthorised patrols around its territory, reaffirming sovereignty and maritime jurisdiction. The developments reflected escalating cross-strait tensions over law enforcement activities and competing territorial claims.



China Supports Economic Coordination Before G7 Summit

China joined a Macron-led virtual meeting advocating greater international economic cooperation ahead of the G7 Summit.

Discussions covered trade stability, global economic recovery, investment cooperation, and efforts to manage growing geopolitical and commercial tensions.



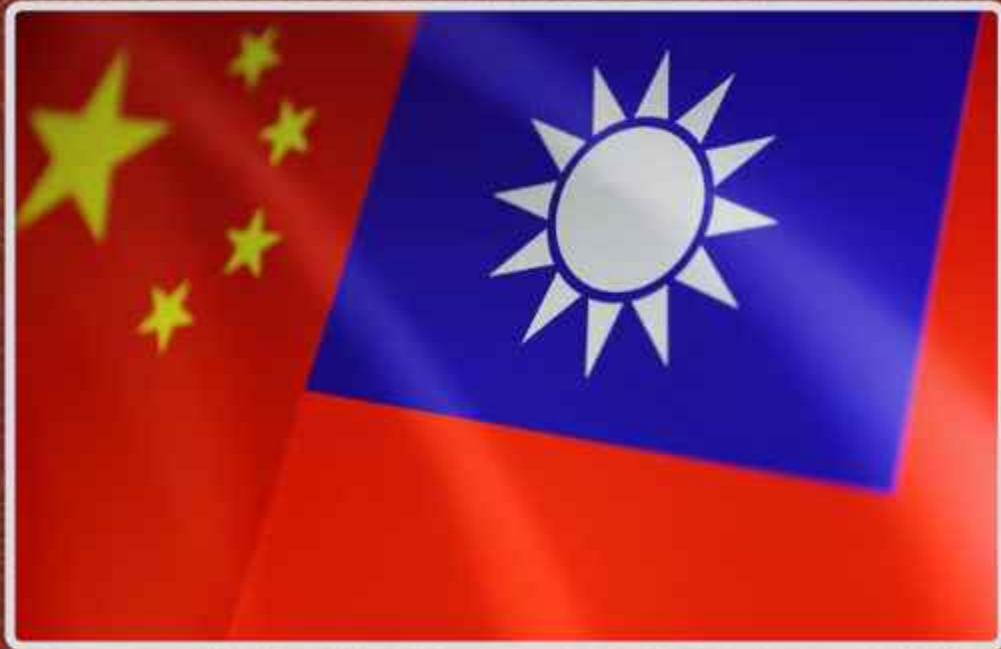
China Sanctions Philippine Defence Secretary

China imposed sanctions on the Philippine Defence Secretary over remarks concerning the South China Sea. Beijing criticised Manila's position on maritime disputes, further intensifying diplomatic tensions and reinforcing competing narratives surrounding regional security.



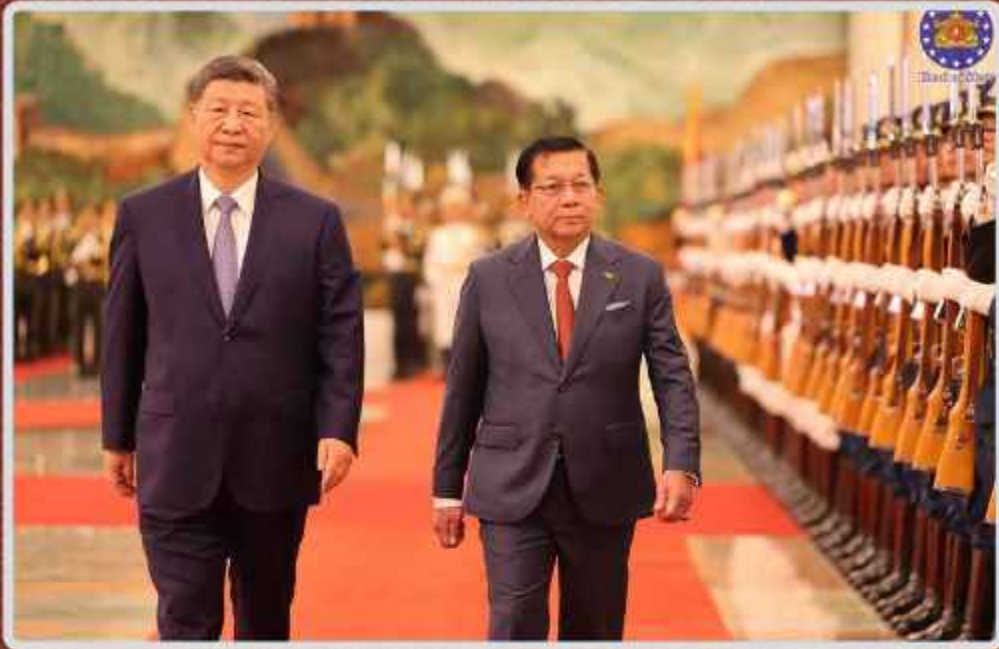
Philippines Rejects Chinese Sanctions

The Philippine Defence Secretary dismissed Chinese sanctions and pledged continued opposition to Beijing's actions in disputed waters. Discussions reaffirmed Manila's commitment to defending sovereignty, strengthening regional partnerships, and resisting coercive maritime behaviour.



Taiwan Launches Intelligence Reporting Platform

Taiwan introduced a new online platform allowing Chinese nationals to report intelligence activities anonymously. The initiative aims to strengthen counterintelligence efforts, encourage defections, and improve information gathering amid increasing espionage concerns across the Taiwan Strait.



Xi Reaffirms China's Support for Myanmar

President Xi Jinping met Myanmar's president in Beijing, reaffirming support for deeper political, economic, and security cooperation. Discussions emphasised Belt and Road projects, border management, regional stability, and China's long-term strategic interests in Myanmar.



EU Advances Strategy to Reduce Dependence on China

The European Union prepared legislation promoting supply chain diversification and strategic resilience. Discussions focused on reducing dependence on China in critical sectors while maintaining trade engagement through a balanced de-risking strategy rather than economic decoupling.



China Tightens Indium Export Controls

China strengthened export checks on indium amid growing AI-related demand. Discussions highlighted resource security, supply chain management, strategic mineral controls, and the geopolitical significance of critical materials supporting semiconductor manufacturing and advanced technologies.



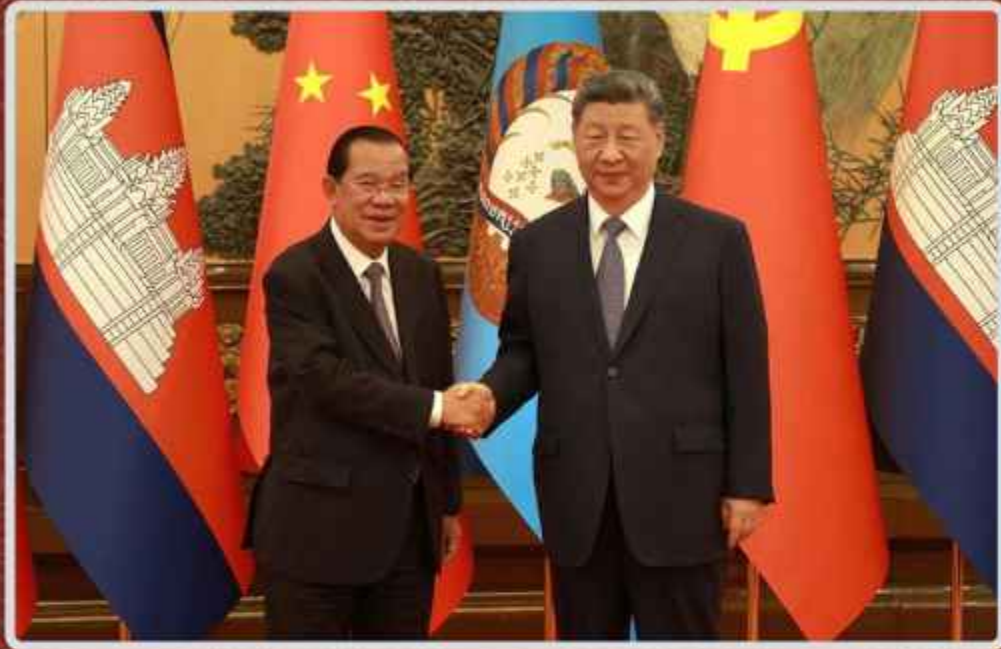
China Calls for BRICS Cooperation on Critical Minerals

China urged BRICS members to strengthen collaboration on strategic minerals, supply chains, and resource security. Discussions focused on reducing external dependencies, enhancing industrial cooperation, and supporting technological development across emerging economies.



Western Powers Express Concern Over Chinese Patrols

The United States, United Kingdom, France, and Germany jointly expressed concern over increased Chinese military and coast guard activities east of Taiwan. Discussions emphasised regional stability, freedom of navigation, and opposition to unilateral actions altering the status quo.



China and Cambodia Strengthen Security Partnership

President Xi Jinping pledged to establish a comprehensive security partnership with Cambodia. Discussions covered defence cooperation, law enforcement, infrastructure development, regional security, and strengthening China's strategic influence in Southeast Asia.



EU Pushes for Progress in Trade Talks with China

The European Union called for concrete outcomes in trade negotiations with China by October. Discussions focused on market access, industrial subsidies, trade imbalances, investment barriers, and efforts to stabilise bilateral economic relations while advancing de-risking objectives.



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
