INDIA'S DIPLOMATIC DIGEST

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INDIA SUPPORTS AFRICA-LED EBOLA RESPONSE

India reaffirmed its commitment to Global South health security by extending support to Africa-led Ebola response efforts. Discussions focused on medical assistance, capacity building, humanitarian cooperation, and strengthening public health resilience through partnership with African institutions, reflecting India's commitment to inclusive global health governance and South-South cooperation.



14TH INDIA-GREECE FOREIGN OFFICE CONSULTATIONS

India and Greece reviewed bilateral cooperation across political, defence, maritime, trade, connectivity, and cultural sectors. Discussions highlighted expanding strategic partnership, strengthening cooperation in the Indo-Pacific and Mediterranean, enhancing economic engagement, and coordinating positions on regional and global developments while preparing for future high-level exchanges.

11TH BRICS FOREIGN POLICY DIALOGUE

The BRICS Foreign Policy Dialogue examined evolving geopolitical developments, multilateral cooperation, Global South priorities, UN reforms, regional conflicts, and international security challenges. Participants reaffirmed support for a more representative global governance architecture while advancing policy coordination ahead of India's BRICS Presidency and upcoming ministerial engagements.



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8TH INDIA-INDONESIA JOINT COMMISSION MEETING

India and Indonesia reviewed cooperation in defence, maritime security, trade, digital economy, connectivity, healthcare, education, and cultural exchanges. Both sides reaffirmed commitment to their Comprehensive Strategic Partnership while discussing Indo-Pacific cooperation, regional stability, supply chain resilience, and expanding economic and people-to-people engagement.



EAM VISITS BULGARIA AND FINLAND

External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar's visit focused on strengthening bilateral relations with Bulgaria and Finland through discussions on trade, technology, innovation, defence, education, connectivity, and European partnerships. Meetings also addressed Ukraine, Indo-Pacific developments, multilateral cooperation, and India's engagement with Nordic and Eastern European partners.

PRIME MINISTER VISITS FRANCE AND SLOVAKIA

PM Modi's visit advanced strategic partnerships with France and Slovakia through discussions on defence, nuclear energy, technology, innovation, trade, space, mobility, and European cooperation. The visit also included participation at the G7 Summit, reinforcing India's commitment to multilateralism and global economic governance.

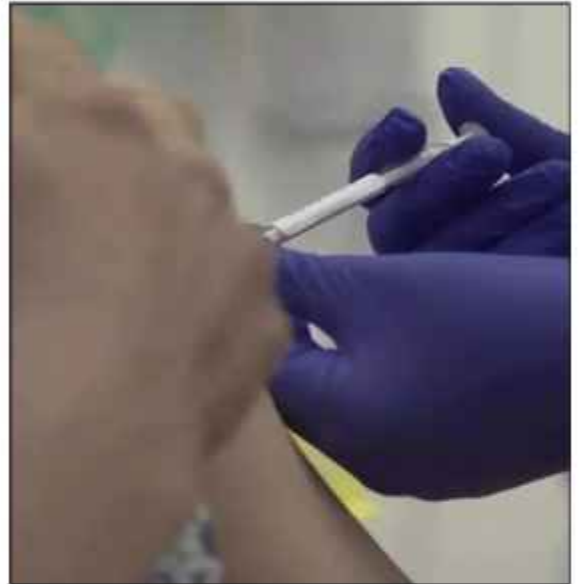


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INDIA DISPATCHES VACCINES TO MALDIVES

India supplied vaccine consignments to the Maldives, reaffirming its role as a trusted healthcare partner under its Neighbourhood First policy. The initiative strengthened bilateral cooperation, supported public health preparedness, and demonstrated India's continued commitment to humanitarian assistance and regional health security.



MOS KIRTI VARDHAN SINGH VISITS TAJIKISTAN

Minister of State Kirti Vardhan Singh's visit focused on enhancing India-Tajikistan cooperation in connectivity, security, counter-terrorism, trade, education, and development partnerships. Discussions reaffirmed strong bilateral relations while emphasizing regional stability, Central Asian engagement, and expanding collaboration under India's Connect Central Asia policy.

2ND INDIA-PAPUA NEW GUINEA FOREIGN OFFICE CONSULTATIONS

India and Papua New Guinea reviewed cooperation in trade, development partnerships, healthcare, education, digital connectivity, defence, and capacity building. Discussions also explored Pacific engagement, climate resilience, people-centric initiatives, and strengthening cooperation under the Forum for India-Pacific Islands Cooperation (FIPIC).



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INDIA-FRANCE LEADERS HOLD OFFICIAL TALKS

PM Modi and President Emmanuel Macron reviewed the India-France Strategic Partnership across defence, nuclear energy, space, Indo-Pacific cooperation, technology, climate action, and economic engagement. Both leaders reaffirmed commitment to strengthening strategic autonomy, multilateral cooperation, and expanding collaboration in emerging technologies.



INDIA-SLOVAKIA STRENGTHEN BILATERAL RELATIONS

PM Modi and Slovak PM discussed expanding cooperation in trade, defence, innovation, mobility, education, digital transformation, and investment. Both leaders reaffirmed support for stronger India-Europe engagement while exploring opportunities for deeper economic and technological partnerships.

PM ADDRESSES G7 SESSION ON GLOBAL PARTNERSHIPS

Addressing the G7 Summit, PM Modi highlighted inclusive growth, Global South priorities, resilient supply chains, sustainable development, AI governance, climate action, and multilateral reforms. He called for rebuilding international solidarity through equitable partnerships and collective responses to contemporary global challenges.



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INDIA-NETHERLANDS HOLD FOURTH CYBER DIALOGUE

India and the Netherlands discussed cybersecurity, cyber resilience, digital governance, critical infrastructure protection, emerging technologies, cybercrime, and capacity building. Both sides agreed to deepen cooperation through information sharing, policy coordination, and strengthening secure digital ecosystems amid evolving cyber threats.



13TH ASEAN-INDIA SOMTC

India and ASEAN officials reviewed cooperation against transnational crimes, terrorism, cybercrime, trafficking, narcotics, money laundering, and organized crime. Discussions emphasized information sharing, capacity building, law enforcement cooperation, and strengthening regional security mechanisms under the ASEAN-India Comprehensive Strategic Partnership.

BRICS NSA'S MEET UNDER INDIA'S CHAIRSHIP

National Security Advisers from BRICS countries discussed counter-terrorism, cybersecurity, emerging technologies, regional security, multilateral cooperation, and strategic stability. The meeting reinforced India's leadership in promoting collective security, enhancing policy coordination, and strengthening BRICS' role in addressing global security challenges.



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EAM VISITS MONGOLIA AND REPUBLIC OF KOREA

External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar's visit strengthened India's engagement with Mongolia and the Republic of Korea through discussions on strategic partnerships, trade, critical technologies, defence, connectivity, Indo-Pacific cooperation, supply chains, and people-to-people exchanges.



INDIA-MOROCCO COUNTER-TERRORISM DIALOGUE

India and Morocco reviewed evolving terrorist threats, counter-radicalisation strategies, terror financing, intelligence sharing, cybersecurity, and law enforcement cooperation. Both sides reaffirmed their commitment to combating terrorism in all forms while strengthening bilateral security cooperation and regional stability.

INDIA-TAJIKISTAN COUNTER-TERRORISM WORKING GROUP

India and Tajikistan strengthened cooperation against terrorism, extremism, radicalisation, terror financing, and cross-border threats. Discussions focused on intelligence exchange, capacity building, regional security, and coordinated efforts to address evolving challenges affecting Central and South Asia.

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12TH INDIA-EU HUMAN RIGHTS DIALOGUE

India and the European Union exchanged views on human rights, democracy, gender equality, rule of law, digital rights, and international cooperation. The dialogue reaffirmed mutual commitment to constructive engagement, respecting differing perspectives while strengthening the broader India-EU Strategic Partnership.



EAM DEEPENS PARTNERSHIP WITH REPUBLIC OF KOREA

During his visit to Seoul, External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar discussed defence, critical technologies, semiconductors, supply chains, economic cooperation, Indo-Pacific security, and regional developments. Both countries reaffirmed commitment to expanding their Special Strategic Partnership across emerging sectors.

INDIA-MAURITIUS LEADERS REVIEW STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP
