INDIA'S DIPLOMATIC DIGEST

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MOS (KVS) VISIT TO GENEVA FOR THE INAUGURAL UN GLOBAL DIALOGUE ON AI GOVERNANCE

India highlighted the need for inclusive, transparent, and responsible global AI governance. Discussions emphasized equitable access to AI technologies, bridging the digital divide, capacity building, ethical innovation, and developing international frameworks that balance technological advancement with safety, trust, and sustainable development.



EAM DR. S. JAISHANKAR'S VISIT TO QATAR

The visit reviewed the entire spectrum of India-Qatar relations, including energy security, trade, investment, defence, technology, diaspora welfare, and regional developments. Both sides reaffirmed their commitment to deepening the strategic partnership and expanding cooperation across emerging sectors.

PRIME MINISTER'S ADDRESS TO THE PARLIAMENT OF INDONESIA

The Prime Minister reaffirmed India's commitment to strengthening the Comprehensive Strategic Partnership with Indonesia. The address emphasized shared democratic values, maritime cooperation, Indo-Pacific stability, economic collaboration, cultural ties, and greater coordination in regional and multilateral institutions.



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14TH INDIA-RUSSIA JOINT WORKING GROUP ON COUNTER TERRORISM

India and Russia reviewed the global and regional terrorist landscape, counter-terrorism cooperation, terrorist financing, radicalization, cyber-enabled terrorism, information sharing, capacity building, and multilateral coordination. Both sides reiterated their commitment to combating terrorism in all its forms and manifestations.



INDIA-AFGHANISTAN JOINT COMMITTEE MEETING

The meeting reviewed ongoing development cooperation, humanitarian assistance, capacity building, connectivity, education, healthcare, and people-centric initiatives. Both sides discussed strengthening bilateral engagement while supporting Afghanistan's socio-economic development and addressing issues of mutual concern.

3RD INDIA-AUSTRALIA ANNUAL SUMMIT

The Prime Ministers reviewed progress under the Comprehensive Strategic Partnership, focusing on trade, defence, critical minerals, education, clean energy, maritime security, technology, and Indo-Pacific cooperation. Both leaders reaffirmed their commitment to strengthening bilateral and regional collaboration.



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OPERATION AMISTAD: INDIA'S HADR MISSION TO VENEZUELA

India successfully concluded Operation Amistad, delivering humanitarian assistance and disaster relief following natural disasters in Venezuela. The mission highlighted India's commitment to humanitarian diplomacy, rapid disaster response, international solidarity, and supporting partner countries during crises.



PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICIAL TALKS WITH THE PRIME MINISTER OF NEW ZEALAND

Leaders reviewed bilateral cooperation in trade, education, agriculture, technology, defence, renewable energy, people-to-people ties, and Indo-Pacific security. Discussions also explored expanding economic engagement and strengthening collaboration in multilateral forums.

VISIT OF AFGHANISTAN'S MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE TO INDIA

Discussions focused on agricultural cooperation, irrigation, livestock development, capacity building, research collaboration, food security, and technology transfer. Both sides explored opportunities to strengthen institutional cooperation and support Afghanistan's agricultural development through technical assistance and knowledge sharing.



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INDIA-BELGIUM STRATEGIC DIALOGUE

India and Belgium reviewed political, economic, technological, defence, cyber, connectivity, and multilateral cooperation. Discussions also focused on the India-EU partnership, Indo-Pacific developments, global security challenges, and expanding collaboration in emerging technologies and innovation.



5TH BIMSTEC NATIONAL SECURITY CHIEFS MEETING

National Security Chiefs discussed regional security challenges, counter-terrorism, cyber security, transnational crime, maritime security, intelligence sharing, disaster response, and strengthening institutional cooperation to enhance peace, stability, and resilience across the BIMSTEC region.

VISIT OF THE PRESIDENT OF ZANZIBAR TO INDIA

The visit focused on strengthening cooperation in trade, maritime security, healthcare, education, capacity building, digital governance, and development partnership. Both sides reaffirmed their commitment to expanding India's engagement with Zanzibar and the wider East African region.



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3RD INDIA-EU TRADE AND TECHNOLOGY COUNCIL MEETING

India and the EU reviewed cooperation in digital technologies, semiconductors, trusted telecommunications, resilient supply chains, clean energy, green technologies, trade facilitation, research, and innovation while advancing a rules-based framework for technology and economic cooperation.



PRESIDENT OF INDIA ADDRESSES INDIA-MOLDOVA BUSINESS FORUM

The President encouraged deeper business engagement between India and Moldova, highlighting opportunities in pharmaceuticals, IT, agriculture, manufacturing, renewable energy, education, and innovation. The address emphasized strengthening economic partnerships and expanding bilateral investment.

QUAD FOREIGN MINISTERS' JOINT PRESS RELEASE ON COOPERATION WITH ASEAN

The Quad reaffirmed ASEAN's centrality in the Indo-Pacific and committed to supporting regional peace, maritime security, connectivity, disaster resilience, cybersecurity, health security, infrastructure, and sustainable development while promoting a free, open, inclusive, and rules-based Indo-Pacific.



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PRESIDENT OF INDIA IN ROMANIA: BILATERAL TALKS

India and Romania reviewed cooperation in trade, investment, defence, energy, education, technology, culture, and mobility. Both sides discussed strengthening bilateral relations, enhancing economic engagement, and expanding cooperation in regional and global forums.



7TH INDIA-UAE JOINT COMMITTEE ON CONSULAR AFFAIRS

The meeting reviewed consular cooperation, labour mobility, visa facilitation, legal assistance, prisoner welfare, expatriate issues, and mechanisms to improve citizen services. Both sides agreed to strengthen institutional coordination to better serve their respective nationals.





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
